INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE WCW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- Check the description in the Scholarship Brochure to determine your eligibility for each scholarship. Apply
 only for the scholarships which you qualify. Be sure to include all of the required paperwork with your
 application by or before the deadline. A record of participation in school activities, clubs or athletics, and
 demonstration of involvement in community organizations is recommended. Work experience, if any,
 should be included in the application.
- 2. Complete the Application Form, Applicant's Statement, Student Activities, and Community Involvement pages. (unless specified otherwise in the scholarship description)
- 3. If you are applying for scholarships that require a demonstration of financial need, have your parents complete the Parents Confidential Statement.
- 4. If you are applying for scholarships that require letters of recommendation, be sure to request the letters well in advance of the deadline to give the writer an opportunity to compose a thoughtful letter. These letters may be used for more than one application.
- 5. Submit an unofficial transcript with each application (unless an official transcript is requested). Transcripts should be requested from Mrs. Ahlin, the school registrar. You may then photocopy your transcript for additional applications.
- 6. Print or photocopy your application for each scholarship. Include the name of the scholarship at the top of page 1 for each scholarship for which you are applying. Staple all parts of each application packet together. Please do not use paperclips or seal applications in large envelopes.
- 7. Ensure that you have followed the directions accurately and have submitted all of the required information and documents. Failure to do so may disqualify your application(s).

All applications must be submitted to Mrs. Fullard in the counseling office, no later than Friday, March 31th by 3:30 p.m. <u>LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.</u> You are encouraged to turn applications in before the deadline.
