Asian Pacific State Employee Association (APSEA)

Auldin Briggs Achievement Scholarship

Five (2) \$2,000 competitive scholarships are available. Each is paid as a one-time award. This scholarship recognizes hard work and perseverance required to overcome challenges and achieve academic goals. Applicants must be a senior currently attending WCW, having been enrolled for the entire junior and senior years. A minimum GPA of 3.00 is required and the applicant must be a Vacaville resident. Applicants must prove academic achievement in challenging courses, and demonstrate a record of service to their school, community and or history of employment. One letter of recommendation from a current teacher is required of all applicants. These scholarships are only for students who will attend a 2-year Community College or Vocational/Technical School. Harry & Eleanor D. Nelson Scholarship

Five (5) \$20,000 competitive scholarships are available. Each one is renewable over four years and will pay out \$5,000 per year (each fall semester/quarter). This scholarship recognizes continued academic excellence and community service. Applicants must be seniors currently attending WCW, having been enrolled for their entire junior and senior years. A minimum GPA of 3.50 is required and the applicant must be a Vacaville resident. A record of involvement in school and community service activities must be demonstrated, and the need for financial assistance must be proven by submitting the most recently filed form 1040. One letter of recommendation from a current employer or volunteer organization leader is required of all applicants. Only students who will attend a 4-year college or university in the state of California, as a full time student, are eligible to apply. Students who plan to attend a 2-year school or TAG program are not eligible to apply.
